Her research focuses on testing interventions to improve maternal and child health, to better prevent and treat chronic disease (obesity, diabetes, cancer, and chronic kidney disease), and to address access to care and social determinants of health issues in high risk and underserved populations. Dr. Yakes Jimenez has published over 40 peer-reviewed nutrition research articles and participates in an average of 6 or more grant submissions per year.
